

Laser Tag of Miami (LTOM) Agreement

1. Laser tag will begin promptly at the agreed upon time and address(es) listed on the invoice. Payment will consist of a 50% deposit for the listed event(s), with the other 50% due promptly the day of the event, unless a written and signed agreement between the host and LTOM has been arranged otherwise altering the terms of payment.
2. In the event of rain, billing is proportional to the amount of time played. When scheduling permits, time not played due to weather postponement may be added to the end of the party for no additional charge to fulfill the amount of play time agreed upon in the invoice. If no time is played due to poor weather, even if LTOM has set up, a full 100% refund of the deposit is in order, unless the host wishes for LTOM to retain the deposit and reschedule for another date. If poor weather postponements and conflicting scheduling permits only a fraction of playtime to occur, payment will follow the formula below:

$$\left(\frac{\text{(Time Played)}}{\text{(Time Booked)}} \times \text{Total Cost of Booking} \right) \text{ minus Deposit Paid}$$

Ex. 1

$$\left(\frac{\text{(Played 45 minutes)}}{\text{(Booked 120 minutes)}} \times (\$440 \text{ total cost}) \right) - (\$220 \text{ deposit paid}) = \text{\textbf{-\$55}}$$

In this scenario, LTOM owes *you* \$55

Ex. 2

$$\left(\frac{\text{(Played 90 minutes)}}{\text{(Booked 120 minutes)}} \times (\$440 \text{ total cost}) \right) - (\$220 \text{ deposit paid}) = \text{\textbf{\$110}}$$

In this scenario, you owe LTOM \$110

3. Water breaks, birthday cake breaks, gift un wrappings, etc, etc are considered "playtime" as well.
4. Referees rules are to be following at all times. Adequate warning will be provided to players who break rules. Those who disregard rules on a repeated and deliberate basis, or otherwise misbehaves in a disruptive fashion, may be asked to sit out some, or even all remaining games for the duration of the party. Players may also be asked to leave the immediate play area. No refunds or credit will be issued to the party host on the basis of any persons misbehavior, and payment of the remaining balance will still be due.
5. The host of the event(s) promises to replace equipment that is destroyed as a result of negligent or excessive abuse by guests, at his or her own expense. Proper documentation of costs will be presented to said host before compensation is to be paid.
6. If an event is canceled with at least 72 hours notice, the host is entitled to a 100% refund of the deposit. If there is a cancellation within 72 hours of the event, the host will forfeit the deposit. This excludes cancellation due to weather concerns, which would fall under section 2 of this agreement.
7. Extensions of event times are only possible if no other events will conflict with the time extension.
